PILOT TRAINING TAKES OFF!

The BLAST! project partners have been busy in the last few months piloting our training programme with local teams of young people in Portugal, Ireland and Turkey.

Advancing Sustainability in Portugal

In Portugal, our focus has been on fostering sustainability through blockchain innovation. Our training workshops have attracted young individuals passionate about addressing the environmental issues plaguing their country. Together, we have explored the potential of blockchain to enhance environmental monitoring, promote renewable energy solutions, and encourage sustainable practices.

Training Initiatives in Ireland

In Ireland, our training programmes have been making significant strides. We have successfully engaged with local schools, further education centres and youth organisations to introduce blockchain concepts and their potential applications in tackling environmental challenges – namely air pollution and biodiversity loss. The enthusiastic participation from young people has been inspiring, with many showcasing their innovative ideas and eagerness to make a difference.

Mitigating Environmental Risks in Turkey

Turkey, a country prone to natural disasters, faces unique challenges related to environmental risks. In collaboration with local schools and youth centres, BLAST! has been training young people on how blockchain technology can contribute to disaster preparedness and response efforts.

Participants in Turkey have delved into blockchain's potential to improve efficient aid distribution and enhance early warning systems. By harnessing the power of blockchain, these young change-makers are taking proactive steps to mitigate the impact of natural disasters and build resilient communities.
